What is covered?

- School physicals
- Sports physicals (annual sports activity participation form must be provided by patient or guardian)
- Vision, hearing and ECG screenings at select locations
- Dental screenings available at West Orange Health Center (upon availability)

Does my child qualify?

Your child must be 18 years old or younger; be uninsured and have no other insurance options.
